With the permission of Lebow, Hicks I continue to offer expert testimony in stigma issues where appraisal may be part of my report as well as testimony in the actions of Realtors. I also am referred by Lois Hicks, for specialized situations from residential to commercial assignments.
- I serve as an advisor to Lebow, Hicks as I have certain expertise that is unique to my work experience that is not commonplace in the appraisal industry. I also provide reports for estates, if there is a potential for a future listing of the property.
- Overall Appraised thousands of residential properties then focussed on commercial work. Have travelled North America for clients multiple times. Have worked on portfolios of over 100 properties for major firms, client list is extensive and serviced not just institutions and corporate but always had (by list of Canadian Business Magazine) between 55% to 60% of Canada's richest people as either direct clients or their firms.

WFE bought old houses, renovated and resold same. This also created many mortgages for our investors. During the three years with WFE I bought about 300-350 houses. We billed ourselves as Toronto' largest home buyers.
- 1972-74 - Lebow And Company Ltd. - again, bought, sold and renovated. The houses were solely my responsibility. During our years we bought and sold another few hundred houses. I maintained full time construction staff.
- 1974 - April 9, 1974, introduction of Land Speculation Tax. Caught with about 25 houses. This lead me to open my real estate brokerage, to dispose of my own houses.
- 1977 - Partner, Hilwood Homes, a builder of new houses. Built approximately 500 houses in the Rosewood (Agincourt) and Brampton areas.
 - Partner in other building companies. Built townhouses in Malton with one group, and new houses in Mississauga with another group.
- 1977 - Hilwood built small office building at 345 Wilson (our offices).
- 1979 - With new investors started Creative Home Group which bought and renovated in the Riverdale and Cabbagetown area. Owned about 25-30 houses.
